

## Title: Making Thinking Visible (MTV) in Physical Education (PE) through Whiteboarding

In Hillgrove, we are continuously challenging ourselves to seek more effective ways to develop competent, confident and thinking sportspeople. By focusing on mastery of games concepts over technical skills in gameplay, we believe that our students will be better able to transfer their learning across the different types of games taught over 4 or 5 years in Hillgrove. The PE department felt that quality questioning must engage all students cognitively and therefore, there is a need to seriously explore ways to help our students make their thinking visible in the PE “classroom”. With this proposed solution, transition time of giving out paper and pens will be minimised and this will certainly lead to more active learning time during PE lessons. While this is works in progress, we believe that this exploration could be a stepping stone towards re-defining what quality PE could look like for the future of our students.
